

## DELIVERING DIFFERENTLY WORKSHOP

### THE PROGRAMME

The [Delivering Differently Challenge](#) is designed to support a small number of pioneering local authorities, either individually or in partnership, to select and implement new models of delivery for some of their services.

Drawing on a £1m fund, local authorities participating in the *Challenge* will have access to bespoke professional support to enable them to review which model is right for the service and decide how to implement it.

### JANUARY WORKSHOP

In order to help senior officers consider how their services and users might benefit from alternative delivery models, PA Consulting will host a workshop on 21<sup>st</sup> January.

In addition to providing an overview of the range of models that can be deployed, including the associated opportunities and risks, attendees will be able to meet and discuss with leaders of organisations that have already adopted different delivery models to provide local authority services.

Open to all authorities, the workshop will be particularly useful for those intending to apply to the Challenge fund. Further information on next steps will be shared, and attendees will be able to ask questions about the application process and the nature of the support offer.
